Help Us Put Our Organs to Bed

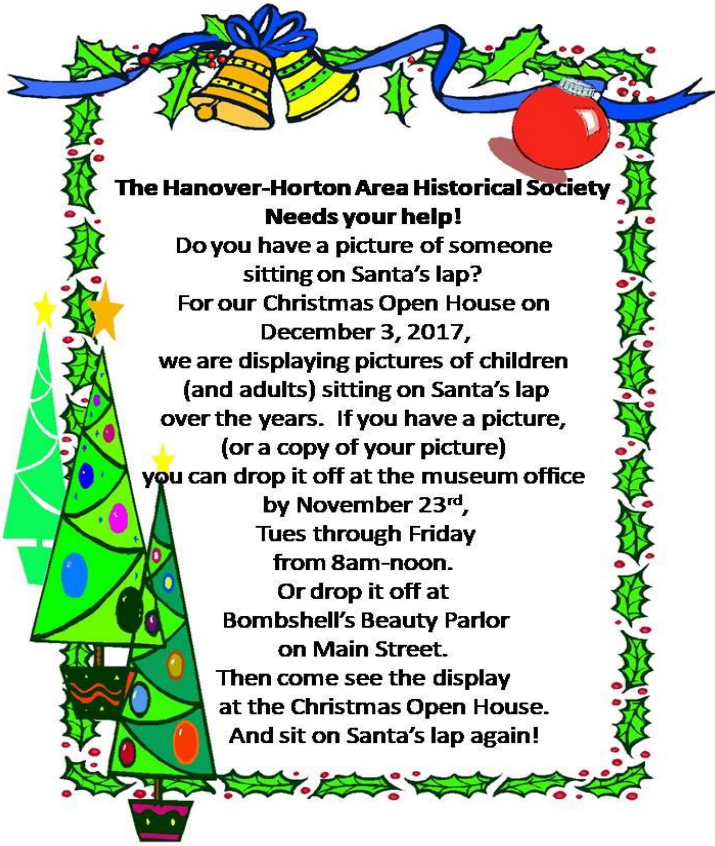
